Reach out by phone or e-mail to your friends and neighbors. This will help them and you as well to feel connected as a community of faith for Faith Harbor UMC.

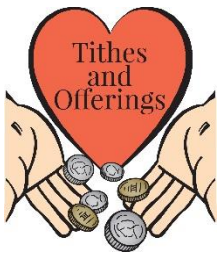


The Harbor Thrift Store contributed \$1,000.00 to Share The Table for our Back Pack KidS who are without adequate nutrition due to school closings.
