Easter Greetings in the name of our risen Lord Jesus Christ!

This Sunday is the third Sunday of Easter, and we will once again be offering an online worship service that will be available for viewing early Sunday morning. Our theme for this Sunday is

"Eye-Opening Experiences."

It is based on Luke 24, when the eyes of the two disciples who had been walking on the Emmaus road with Jesus were opened to recognize the risen Lord when He broke bread and gave it to them.

Recognizing the presence of the Lord in our lives is an important component of discipleship. It is especially necessary to be able to perceive the presence of Christ in our lives during times like the present time. I pray that we are all regularly recognizing the presence of Christ in our lives, our homes and our world, even in the midst of these difficult and uncertain times. Yesterday our Governor extended the North Carolina stay-at-home order until May 8th and announced a three-phase plan to reopen the state. The first phase could begin as early as May 9th if certain requirements are met. That phase would last a minimum of two weeks. While in phase one, we would still be prohibited from gatherings of more than ten persons. So at the very least we are looking at another four weeks of "virtually" worshiping together.

During this continued time of required separation, please be sure to check out our worship services on our website (faithharborumc.org), and please be sure to check on one another. It is especially important in these challenging times that we express our love and concern for one another and that we very intentionally support each other in prayer. Please consider that your phone call, text, card or visit from 6 feet away might be a means by which Christ opens the eyes of someone else to his presence and his love.

May our Lord, who promised never to leave or forsake us, open our eyes fully to his presence today and always.




MOTHER'S DAY HONORS OR MEMORIES
