Finance Report for June 2020 and Year to Date Totals

June contributions \$ 22,907.50 including \$7035 on line

Year to Date Contributions \$180,832.50

Year to Date Budget \$215,967.

Many of our budgeted expenses continue to be temporarily eliminated or significantly decreased. Contributions for June are approximately \$ 13,000 less than May.

As Pastor David has discussed in the Wednesday Messenger we are collecting funds to purchase on line streaming equipment so necessary in these times of social distancing and for future needs. Through July 5th we have collected \$1650.00 of the expected costs of \$13,000.
