Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

# I am excited to announce our *plans to return to in-person worship in our Sanctuary this Sunday, August 16<sup>th</sup>.*

The leadership of our church has developed the following protocol and precautions to ensure maximum safety for all who come to worship with us.

- We will have just one service for the time being, at 9:20 AM.
- Everyone who does not have a role in leading worship will be expected to wear a mask throughout the service.
- We will sing!
- Extra masks will be available at the door.
- There will be several hand-sanitizing stations.
- Upgraded filters will be installed in our HVAC system.
- Everyone who enters will have their temperature taken with a forehead thermometer. Anyone with a fever or other symptoms of COVID-19 will not be able to enter.
- Everyone who enters will be asked to provide their name and phone number so that we can notify each person in the event of a need for contact tracing.
- Every other row of chairs will be removed to ensure social distancing practices and to maintain 50% occupancy restrictions.
- Chairs will be disinfected before each service.
- Family groups may sit together; otherwise social distancing of no less than 6 feet is expected.
- There will be no bulletins or hymnals.
- The "passing of the peace" will be without physical contact.
- There will be no Sunday school classes, children's programs or other small group meetings. Only the sanctuary will be disinfected and utilized.
- There will be no receiving line or congregating in the building after worship. Worshippers will be asked to exit the building as soon as the service is over and will be encouraged to use the doors at the end of both hallways in addition to the main front door to avoid congestion at the front door.
- Persons are welcome to greet one another after the service in the parking lot or under the portico, but please do not block the exit path of those who are still leaving the building.

We will continue to provide an online worship experience for those who are not yet ready or able to worship in the Sanctuary. We are moving forward with the installation of live-streaming equipment. I hope you will plan to join us for in-person or virtual worship this Sunday!

#### A new program is coming to Faith Harbor - FAN (Faith, Activity and Nutrition).

Kim King has completed the online training from the University of South Carolina and will be bringing the program into the life of our church. The **FAN** program is designed to help churches create a healthy church environment that supports physical activity and healthy eating. **FAN** is not an exercise program or a cooking class. Instead, the goal of **FAN** is to reach the entire congregation by creating a church environment where members regularly see and hear health messages and have healthier options available. **FAN** will encourage us to increase physical activity and healthy eating using four key strategies:
