Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

I want to take this opportunity to introduce you to a Bible study we will be offering at the church this Fall. If you have been wanting to get involved in a Bible study group that draws you closer to God and to other people in our church, I have some great news for you! **Beginning Tuesday**, **September 29**th we will be offering the study called *Experiencing God*. The subtitle to *Experiencing God* is "Knowing and Doing the Will of God." This 13-week study is based on seven Scriptural realities that teach us how to develop a true relationship with our Creator.

Some of you may be familiar with *Experiencing God*. It has been around for 30 years, although the current edition has been revised and expanded. A number of persons in our Faith Harbor family engaged in the study when it was offered in our church several years ago, and all of those I have spoken to about it highly recommend it. Some have said they would love to take it again if it is offered.

Here is what the author, Henry Blackaby, wrote about *Experiencing God:*

I have been overwhelmed by the response to Experiencing God. So many lives have been radically changed: inmates, military personnel, lawyers, judges, CEOs, professional athletes, politicians, parents.

The study has transformed thousands of churches, high schools, colleges, and seminaries.

Because of this study, countless people are now serving as missionaries, pastors, evangelists, and faithful servants. Only heaven truly knows all the ways God has used

Experiencing God to impact the world.

If this seems like something that would interest you, please plan to join us at the church on **Tuesdays** from 6:30-8:00 PM beginning September 29th. We will meet in the Sanctuary, and will practice the same safety guidelines that we are using for our in-person Sunday worship service (these guidelines can be found on our website). There will be a 20 to 30-minute video each week followed by group discussion. Each participant will receive a workbook with daily lessons and readings that correspond with the theme for each week. The cost of the workbook is \$12. Scholarships are available.

To help us with planning, it is important that we know how many people to expect. If you plan to attend, please send an email to Judy Clemmons at secretary@faithharborumc.org and inform her of your intentions to be a part of the study. If you are interested in participating in Experiencing God but you cannot attend on Tuesday evenings, please let me know. Depending on the response we get, it may be necessary to offer the study at a different time. We might even try a Zoom group if there is enough interest.

May you each be filled with the knowledge of God's will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God. (Col. 1:9-10)

The Tenth Anniversary of the Harbor Thrift Store is recognized this month.

We are surely blessed for the success enjoyed over the past ten years and appreciate all the volunteer clerks, warehouse workers, and faithful customers who make this success possible.

More importantly, we recognize that this success would not be possible without the generosity of the

many donors of household furnishings, quality children's clothing, serviceable linens, home décor items, classy jewelry and seasonal decorations.

In reflection of this success, over the <u>first seven years of operation</u> the Harbor Thrift contributed \$122,000.00 to Faith Harbor United Methodist Church to help stabilize the financial status of the Church.

Also, in 2016 the Harbor Thrift Store made a pledge of \$40,000.00 to Build the Vision, subsequently paying that pledge in full by 2018.

In 2017 as a ministry under the United Methodist Women the Harbor Thrift Store has continued to contribute all available funds for a variety of programs supporting women and children; with the primary agency being, Methodist Home for Children. Presently, the Harbor Thrift continues to support the Methodist Home For Children in addition to redirecting funds to several local programs, Mercy Abounds, Share The Table and Back Pack Kids Food needs and School Supplies.

Currently, the Thrift Store warehouse is <u>almost bare</u>, <u>we need donations</u> of all sorts: home furnishings, gently used children's clothing and baby equipment. Please no electronics or adult clothing.

The warehouse is open every Monday with Sherry Mewborn (910) 526-2673 being available to accept donations.
