Advent Greetings in the name of Christ our Lord!

As I am writing this it is exactly two weeks until Christmas Day. I don't know how it is for you, but for me it seems that every year, even though I have known it was coming for a whole year, Christmas still has a way of catching me off guard by its imminent arrival.

This Sunday will be the third Sunday of Advent, the season of waiting and preparing for the arrival of Christmas. This week our focus in worship will be the Light of Christ who came into the world to dispel our darkness. For those of us living in the northern hemisphere, the day of the year with the most hours of darkness occurs in the same week we celebrate Christmas. That means of course that beginning with the week of Christmas, the daylight hours begin to increase. It seems especially fitting to me that darkness begins to lose its grip on our world with the corresponding arrival of the Everlasting Light.

We will celebrate the birth of Christ, the Light of the world, with two Christmas Eve candlelight services, one at 5:00 PM and one at 7:00 PM. We know that Christmas Eve is a time when we customarily have many visitors. In order to try and ensure that we have room for visitors while maintaining safe social distancing, we are asking the members of our congregation to make reservations for these services. We will limit the number of reservations for each service, leaving ample room for visitors. You will find instructions elsewhere in this Messenger for making reservations with Judy. If you make reservations that you later realize you will not be able to keep, we ask that you notify Judy as early as possible out of consideration for others who wish to attend worship. We will be live streaming at least one of the services (watch for further details).

We will require more ushers on Christmas Eve than we normally need. Please contact Frank Tarbell or Marion Shade if you are able to serve as an usher at either service. No experience is required!

It is with a grateful heart that I thank each and every one for the many prayers offered on my behalf during my recent hospitalization. The lovely cards, phone and text messages encouraged me each day during my recovery.

The amazing message in my health episode was nothing short of "DIVINE INTERVENTION" as I had no symptoms whatsoever of Cholesterol issues.

My primary Doctor had ordered an X-ray of my right shoulder due to severe nerve pain. However, the X-ray Technician not only identified nerve pain issue but notified my primary Doctor that there was a large shadow involving the right carotid artery which needed to be investigated further with an Ultrasound.

The Ultrasound and CAT Scan showed the artery was totally blocked, yet I experienced none of the obvious symptoms. Needless to say, surgery was my only alternative as the Surgeon, Dr. David Weatherford informed me and my oldest son that the artery being totally blocked might preclude successful surgery. WE prayed and Pastor David prayed with me.

The LORD must have had other plans for me for He guided this skilled Surgeon and his care team throughout the procedure and my week-long struggle with blood pressure issues that kept me hospitalized. WE prayed, YOU prayed and Pastor David prayed with me.

It is with heartfelt thanks to all, I am doing well and have been profoundly moved by this experience and my walk with God.
