Greetings in the name of our risen and ascended Lord!

I intentionally included the word "ascended" in that greeting because I am writing this on Thursday, Ascension Day, the day forty days after our Lord's resurrection when he was taken up into heaven while his disciples witnessed. We affirm our belief in the Ascension of the Lord each time we recite the creeds, as we declare, "he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father." Since we do not typically gather for worship on Thursdays, the church commemorates the Ascension of the Lord on the Sunday following Ascension Day. This Sunday our Scripture readings will be two passages that describe the Ascension. Our focus will be on the last words Jesus spoke to his disciples just before He was taken up, when He told them, "you will be my witnesses." We will consider together what it means for us that Jesus is sitting at the right hand of the Father, and what it means to be His witnesses. I hope you will be able to join us either on the beach at 8:00, or in the Sanctuary at 9:20.

The 9:20 service will be special for another reason this Sunday, and that is the recognition of our graduating seniors; **Cameron Barnes, Paige Swain** and **Noah Schiefelbein**. We will present our graduates with gifts and say a special prayer for them. There will be an opportunity to greet them in the narthex after the service.

After greeting the graduates, we will gather back in the Sanctuary to begin a six-week study called "The Prodigal God." This video-based Bible study and the book with the same title were written by author and pastor Tim Keller. He is my favorite pastor. Copies of the book will be available for \$9.00. If you are not able to join us on Sunday mornings, we will also offer the study via Zoom on Wednesday evenings at 6:30 beginning May 19th.

Just before the pandemic began a little over a year ago, we made the decision to purchase pew Bibles, since we did not have Bibles in our Sanctuary for worshippers to use. Due to precautions associated with COVID, we have not yet placed the Bibles in our Sanctuary chairs, but we are planning to do so soon. We are hoping to cover the cost of these Bibles by offering the opportunity for persons to purchase them in honor or memory of a loved one. A label will be placed inside each Bible with the name of the person who is being honored or memorialized, and the name of the person who is presenting the Bible. Bibles may be purchased in someone's honor or memory for ten dollars on a first-come, first-serve basis. Please contact Judy in our office to purchase a Bible.

While on the topic of memorializing a loved one, I want to be sure to mention that the memorial service for Ed Drudge will be in our Sanctuary next Saturday, May 22nd at 11 AM. Rebecca will have refreshments in her home for family and friends immediately after the service.
