The following message is for those who may have missed Pastor David's email earlier this week announcing a return to requiring masks for our indoor worship services:

Dear Friends,

I am writing with an important announcement, and I thought I would begin with a few background facts:

- 1. Like many of you, I very much dislike being required to wear a mask in any setting.
- 2. Like some of you, I am not at all worried about the safety of COVID-19 vaccines.
- 3. While extraordinarily rare "breakthroughs" have happened even in our own church family, only 0.1% of COVID-19 cases reported this year in the vast majority of the United States have occurred in persons who have been fully vaccinated (see the excerpt below from an article in Tuesday's Wall Street Journal). In other words, if you get the vaccine, it is extremely unlikely that you will get COVID-19, and if you do get it after having been vaccinated, your symptoms are likely to be comparatively mild.
- 4. At least in part because 1, 2 and 3 are true, I have chosen like many of you to get fully vaccinated.
- 5. Like many of you, I believe no one should be compelled or forced to get vaccinated.
- 6. However, at least in part because 1, 2 and 3 are true, I really wish that everyone who is eligible to get the vaccine would get vaccinated.
- 7. Although I got vaccinated at least in part so that we could all be done with wearing masks, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has recently made the following recommendation for those who have been fully vaccinated: *To reduce the risk of being infected with the Delta variant and possibly spreading it to others, wear a mask indoors in public if you are in an area of substantial or high transmission*.
- 8. The entire state of North Carolina is considered to be in an area of high transmission.
- 9. **Most importantly**, I strongly believe we need to do all we can to protect those who are not eligible to receive the vaccine; namely, children under the age of 12.

10. This Sunday, we are inviting the children in our congregation to bring their backpacks forward for a blessing as the new school year begins. Those children and their parents need to know that their safety and protection is of the utmost importance to us, this Sunday and always.

In prayerful consideration of all the above and in consultation with others, I have determined that beginning with this coming Sunday, August 22nd, it is necessary to return to the mask requirement for all who attend our indoor worship services. I pray that this requirement will be short-lived. The mask requirement will be optional for those in the chancel (stage) area who have speaking or singing roles. We will re-evaluate this situation soon and often. Your understanding and cooperation are greatly appreciated. Please pray that a vaccine will soon be approved and available for young children, and that God will bring an end to this pandemic soon.

May God bless us and keep us safe.

The <u>Delta variant</u> of the Covid-19 virus appears to be breaking through the protection vaccines provide at a higher rate than previous strains, a Wall Street Journal analysis found, though infections among the fully inoculated remain a tiny fraction of overall cases, and symptoms tend to be milder. U.S. states counted at least 193,204 so-called <u>breakthrough cases among vaccinated people</u> between Jan. 1 and early August, according to data that health departments in 44 states and Washington, D.C., provided to the Journal. The figure represents 0.1% of the more than 136 million fully vaccinated people in those states and the capital. (Wall Street Journal, Robbie Whelan and Jared S. Hopkins, August 17, 2021)

Graduation marks an important milestone for a Zoe Empowers group, but it is by no means the end of the project. In addition to the individual accomplishments which will sustain them into the future, Zoe groups have forged such strong bonds during their three years in the program that they remain committed to each other and, in the great majority of cases, continue their regular weekly meetings. These young people have come to see themselves as the agents of change in their own lives and their community and now no longer need Zoe's interventions.

Zoe keeps in contact with many graduated members and has observed that the graduates continue to:

- Protect each other from mistreatment and provide a safety net in times of hardship.
- Reach out to others, teaching what they have learned and helping empower the poor and vulnerable.
