Dear Faith Harbor Family,

I had planned to write about something else today, but after yesterday's terrorist attack(s) in Afghanistan, everything else seems to pale in significance. Original reports were that there were two explosions at the Kabul airport; now it is being reported that there may have been only one. What we do know is that 90 Afghans and 13 US military personnel were killed. Additionally, 150 Afghans and 18 US servicepersons were injured.

The loss of servicepersons certainly hits close to home in our area that has such a strong military presence and is so close in proximity to Camp Lejeune. I was told this morning that six persons from just the subdivision where Kim and I live are stationed in Afghanistan. As of the time of this writing, names of those killed have not yet been released. I can only imagine the dread and fear that families and loved ones are experiencing as they wait for news. Whether those killed were from nearby or from farther away, we know that loved ones will be grieving the loss of spouses, parents, children, siblings and fellow service members. May God comfort and sustain the surviving loved ones during this time of tragic loss.

We are vividly reminded of the sacrifices and risks that our servicepersons and their families are constantly making on our behalf. We all too easily take those things for granted most of the time. May we remember to pray for and give thanks to those who serve so that we can enjoy the blessings of freedom. May we also remember the Afghan people who do not have the freedoms we enjoy, in particular all those who are also mourning and grieving this day.

This Sunday during both services, we will have a moment of silence to remember and honor those who have lost their lives. In the meantime, please keep in your prayers all those who are serving as well as their families, and especially remember to pray for those who are grieving the loss of loved ones.

May God grant comfort, mercy, and strength to all who mourn, and may the peace of the Lord be with each of you.


