Grace and peace to you in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

I am writing this morning from New York City, where I have traveled with my dad, son and grandson on a baseball trip. We have tickets tonight to see our fifth game in six days, each one in a different stadium. It has been a wonderful time for four generations of baseball fans to spend time together and enjoy watching the game we love.

One of the things that is apparent when you watch a baseball game is how much of what happens is contingent upon the umpires. The players are the stars. They have the athletic skills and abilities that everyone comes to watch. The managers often have a high-profile role as well, deciding who plays where and when. The umpires are far less well known, yet not a single pitch is thrown or a play made apart from the oversight and decision-making of the umpires. They have the authority and the final word on whether a pitch is a ball or strike, and whether a player is safe or out on any given play. They may occasionally rely on video replays to help make the call, but even then, the umpires make the final call. They are the authority. Whatever they say goes.

It's interesting to me how the highly paid superstars and managers submit to the authority of the relatively unknown umpires, and even take care not to get on their "bad side." Occasionally players and managers will argue an umpire's decision, but it doesn't get them anywhere other than perhaps thrown out of the game.

You may be wondering what any of this has to do with the you or our church! Well, my point is that no matter what our position or station is in life, we all have to answer to a higher authority. No matter how famous or talented or rich or successful or powerful any of us might be, we will still have someone or something above us. Ultimately of course, the One above us all is God. God alone establishes the laws and precepts and rules that govern our lives. God is the final authority. He has the last word.

Thankfully, the comparison with umpires goes only so far. God is very used to people arguing with Him, and He will not throw us out of the game of life for doing so. God gives us second and third and ten-thousandth chances to change the outcome of our lives. Even so, it does not go well for us when we resist God's authority over our lives. The sooner we learn to trust God's decisions and His authoritative word, the better life will go for us.

As enjoyable as my baseball trip has been, I am looking forward to being back home in North Carolina tomorrow and worshipping our God with you on Sunday. I hope to see you then!
