Each time we recite the Apostles' Creed during worship to affirm what we believe as Christians, we profess to believe among other things in *the communion of saints*. We may not often give those words much consideration. We may not even be very sure what they mean.

This Sunday, November 7th is the day designated as All Saints' Sunday on the church calendar. During both the 8:00 and 9:20 worship services, we will have the opportunity to reflect on what the *communion of saints* is, and what it means for us to be a part of it.

On All Saints' Day we commemorate all Christians, past and present, who are part of the communion of saints. We especially remember those who have gone on to be with the Lord. In our Methodist tradition, we name in particular those members of our church family who have died since the previous All Saints' Day. This year we will memorialize Jim Ace and Gail Kaufmann.

Additionally, when we come forward to receive Holy Communion on Sunday, we all have the opportunity to light candles in memory of those saints in our lives who are now part of that great cloud of witnesses in the presence of the Lord. We give thanks for their influence and the example of their lives, and we claim the promise of being reunited with them in the final resurrection.

I hope to see many of you this Sunday on this special and sacred day in the life of the church.
