To be able to properly prepare, the hospitality team needs to know how many to expect. During both services of worship this coming Sunday, sign-up sheets will be distributed that will allow you to indicate your plans to attend and a food dish that you might plan to bring. If you are not able to sign up this Sunday but plan to attend, please contact Kim MacDougall in the church office by Wednesday the 15<sup>th</sup>.

We will be implementing special precautions for this meal in order to try to keep everyone as safe as possible while allowing the opportunity to celebrate the season and enjoy a meaningful time of fellowship together. Next week's Messenger will provide the details of the safety practices we will put into place.

I hope to see you all soon, and I thank God for the privilege of being your pastor.




The Worship Planning Team has ordered 35 poinsettias.
