To make a donation to provide relief directly to those suffering from the Midwest tornadoes last week, you can make a check out to Faith Harbor, then indicate in the memo line: Midwest Tornado Disaster Response, Advance 200902. We will see to it that those donations are promptly forwarded to UMCOR. Of course, you can also donate directly to UMCOR through their website: umcmission.org.

May God grant mercy and comfort to all who suffer, and may we be a means of extending God's comfort in whatever ways we are able, in the name and Spirit of the One who came to be God with us.




YOUTH MINISTRY NEWS
