With the postponement of General Conference until 2024, the uncertain status of the Protocol for Reconciliation and Grace through Separation and the launching of the Global Methodist Church, Bishop Fairley from our NC Annual Conference posted an announcement on May 17th regarding the process to follow for churches that wish to disaffiliate from the United Methodist Church. Many people have asked questions about the requirements and the process, so I wanted to pass along the website so everyone can review the details. Here are the brief steps, but you can read the details on the website link below.

Disaffiliation Process Steps:

- 1. Complete the Disaffiliation Inquiry Form
- 2. Complete the Preliminary Disaffiliation Agreement
- 3. Request for Church Conference and Call by the District Superintendent
- 4. Church Conference Votes to Approve Disaffiliation by 2/3 Majority
- 5. Compliance with Terms & Conditions Before the Disaffiliation Date
- 6. Annual Conference Ratification at Duly Called Annual Conference
- 7. Organizational Transition (as of Disaffiliation Date)
- 8. All steps must be completed before December 31, 2023
