




Acts 2.37-38: Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart and said to Peter and to the other apostles, "Brothers, what should we do?" Peter said to them, "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ so that your sins may be forgiven; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."

The Apostle Peter had just gotten done preaching his first sermon – and 3,000 people came to Peter and asked what they should do. They asked this because their hearts had been touched by the message of the gospel. That in Jesus Christ there was good news for folks from all over the Mediterranean. As a result of their hearts being touched – they asked what they should do. So, Peter said to repent and be baptized. In the action of repentance, and in the action of baptism – there would be the gift of the Holy Spirit.

This Sunday we will be celebrating baptism down at the South End of Topsail. Right after our 9.20am service gets done – we will all be invited to continuing our worship service at the South End. You are invited to caravan down there with others. We have four people that have lived out this admonition from the Apostle Peter. We have gathered together for the last four weeks and gone through what is repentance and what is baptism.

A Letter from your Lay Leader...

"Trust" Do we really trust God? Be honest, how many times have you handed a burden over to the Lord, but later find yourself still worrying about it? or trying to fix it? To trust God means to let go and let God. He is far better equipped to handle everything we hand Him than we are.

Let's say you are at the location the picture was taken, and God was to tell you to follow the path that is before you. Just looking at it, it looks like it is a dead end. But if you were to have faith and follow His direction, you would see as you follow the path it would be revealed to you that it leads to the right. God has a way, a plan for each of us. The path is not always clear at first but when we start following Him it starts to become clear. But if we don't trust the Lord and don't take that first step forward, because we fear the dead end ahead, we will miss the

blessing He has instore for us. The Missional Discipleship Training Tuesday was very enjoyable. We broke up into our small groups for the first time. We learned about the Kairos Circle. Kairos – Time is right (conditions are right) right for an action, opportunity, a decisive moment.

Kairos Circle – Observe what happened and how did you react or feel? Reflect, why did I feel the way I did and what does that say about me? Discuss it with people you can trust. Plan, a way to grow that is practical. Accountable, tell your plan to another person. Act, Do it! What has God revealed to you? What is He calling you to do or be a part of? Are you trusting in Him to guide you and provide you with the tools you need to accomplish the task at hand? Remember we are not to lean on our own understanding but acknowledge Him and He WILL direct our paths.

Baptism Day ... September 25th at 10:30 a.m


Let's carry-on together to the South end, as Milly, Ruthie, Lainie, and Brooklyn begin their journey with Christ through the baptismal waters.
