

Matthew 6.26-29: "Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? And which of you by worrying can add a single hour to your span of life? And why do you worry about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they neither toil nor spin, yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not clothed like one of these."

I have been contemplating this passage over the last few days. I have had to try to not be in a hurry in this contemplation. For a moment – just read these words from Jesus: "Look at the birds of the air." And then these words: "Consider the lilies of the field."

So often we just want to go straight to the lesson we are to learn – that our heavenly Father provides all our needs – so

why fret! But what if we were to take a really long pause between "Look at the birds of the air" and the rest of the passage? What if that pause is for an hour? or a day? or a month? Jesus instructs us to look at the birds — and in looking at creation we learn more about our loving heavenly Father who created all things. Maybe this could include dolphins, ghost crabs, and sea turtles. Look upon God's creation.


What if we were able to take a really long pause between "Consider the lilies of the field" and the rest of the passage? What if that pause is for an hour? or a day? or a month? What if we gaze upon this beauty that just emerges from the ground. What if we consider the beauty that God has created and we are reminded about how God created all things good – even ourselves.

The Lord is the great artist – who takes dirt and sun and seeds and makes daffodils. The Lord is the great artist who created creatures like bears and dragonflies and sea turtles. I absolutely love observing the sea turtles we have here in Surf City. I love that we care for sea turtle nests and that we have a world-renowned hospital for sea turtles to be nursed back to health. This last week there was a release of six sea turtles from the Karen Beasley Sea Turtle Rescue and Rehabilitation Center. They are beautiful creatures that reflect that beauty of a creative God who made all things good.

I would encourage us all to look and consider – and as a result of this contemplation – create! On Sunday, November 20<sup>th</sup> we are going to have an art show at Faith Harbor. We are inviting everyone from the congregation to consider / contemplate / look at the Gospel of Luke. As you gaze upon Jesus – consider creating something. That can be a performance piece (a song, a dance, a poem, an instrumental...) or a display piece (drawing, painting, metal work, sculpture, furniture, wood work...). As you can see – our creator God is an artist – look upon the sea turtles! So, let us reflect our creator God in sharing the noble work of being creators as well. ~Philip Chryst
