

But the wilderness can also be a time that is disconcerting. It can feel like you are wandering and maybe even confused. It can even feel like you are experiencing a time of testing. Jesus was tested in the wilderness and the test giver was Satan.

I invite you into the wilderness as well. The wilderness is part of what it means to follow Jesus. I invite you to a time of wandering – maybe even a time where you struggle with not knowing what is going on and/or what to do. But it is in the wilderness where the wild beasts become your friends. It is in the wilderness where the angels come and minister to us. It is in the wilderness where the Holy Spirit will sometimes "drive" us.

Here at Faith Harbor the wilderness is part of our journey with Jesus. And while on this journey my prayer is that we can find some old chairs to rest on. But most of all I pray that on this wilderness we rely on the Holy Spirit's guidance. Knowing that the God who began a good work in us will surely see it to completion.
