

Genesis 2.7-8: "then the Lord God formed man from the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and the man became a living being. And the Lord God planted a garden in the east; and there he put the man whom he had formed."

Genesis 2.15: "The Lord God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to till it and keep it."

This last Tuesday about 50 people went on a mission that involved sand, sidewalks, cigarette butts, trash, sunsets, laughing, praying, reading scripture, and table fellowship. This involved small children, parents, grandparents – it involved caring for creation as ones that have been created – it involved bending down and

making sure that God's beauty is the focus, rather than discarded trash. This was the living out of God's mission of re-creation, that we get the joyful pleasure to participate in.

In Genesis chapter 2 we get a glimpse of what humanity's job was. It was a job that involved tilling the ground and keeping/taking care of the garden. This garden was humanity's place to inhabit – and humanity had a job to do. Because of humanity's relationship with the Lord – they cared for creation. The created were instructed to care for creation – based on their relationship with the creator. Imagine this first scene – God on hands and knees forming the dust / dirt / sand being. And this dust being then is given mouth-to-mouth by the Lord God and life is breathed into creation. Humanity inhales God's breath. That our first breath was from the Lord's mouth. And now – may our exhale be God's breath into the world.

Let us as God's ambassadors be sensitive to the mission of God that is all around us. Let us hold fast to the simple things of picking up cigarette butts and trash. Let us hold fast to the simple things like sharing a


