Good Friday Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

As I mentioned in an email earlier today, it is natural for us to wonder why it is that this day when our Lord suffered and died is referred to as "good." Good Friday is "good" because it resulted in God's forgiveness and salvation being poured out on humanity. Without that awful day of suffering that Jesus endured on the cross, we would be forever lost in our sins and forever separated from God. Without Good Friday, there could be no Easter, no joy of resurrection, and no promise of eternal life. Easter could not have happened without the darkness of Good Friday.

Our Good Friday service of Darkness, called a Tenebrae service, will be at the church at 7 PM tonight. We will hear the story of what Jesus endured on our behalf as we extinguish candles to represent the light of Christ being taken out of the world.

On Easter morning we will celebrate our Lord's resurrection, the best news the world has ever received and the event on which all of human history pivots. We will have three services, a 7 AM sunrise service at Soundside Park (bring your own chairs and dress warmly!) and two services at the church, one at 9:20 and one at 11:00. We are hoping to have enough room for everyone who wishes to worship with us, and we are especially concerned about attendance at the 9:20 service. We have added a row of chairs in the sanctuary and extra chairs in the narthex. We believe it will further be helpful if a number of you will plan to attend either the 7 AM or 11 AM services.

Looking beyond Easter, I want to remind all of our members of the church conference that will take place after the 9:20 worship service on April 18th. The purpose of this conference will be to vote on proceeding with the construction of two new classrooms which will allow us to open a pre-K school in our church. I hope many of our members will plan to be in attendance. Only members will be eligible to vote, and you must be present to vote. Melissa Schleinkofer will be making a presentation to the church regarding the pre-school on Tuesday, April 13th at 6:30 via Zoom. We will send an invitation to this meeting to all of our members.

I am excited and exceedingly grateful for the many ways God is moving in our midst, and for the faithfulness of the people of God at Faith Harbor church. May God richly bless you and yours as we commemorate the passion, death and resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
