So, the next generation was blessed with the promised land because they took courage and crossed the Jordan in faith and took what was given to them by God.

I am so excited with my personal Bible Study I have chosen this year. Throughout my life I have read the Bible through a few times. I couldn't tell you how many times I have read the Bible through but this year I am truly getting something out of this reading. I am doing the Bible Recap, which is a study of the whole bible chronologically, which I haven't done before. In my previous readings, it was just that, reading the scriptures that were required that day. I had tried several times to take notes, but I would lose interest when it came to the names. Don't get me wrong, I always learned something new with every reading of the scriptures, but this year is different. With the Bible Recap I listen to someone read it, after that I read it and highlight and/or underline scripture that speaks to me, I take notes and lastly, I listen to Tara-Leigh Copple recap the scriptures. Sometimes I hear what she hears, other times, something else is brought to my attention. But overall I love seeing God in the Scriptures. I am more aware this time, so I am seeing how the law flows through the scriptures. I can see how some of the Levitical laws is used in some of the situations Ruth found herself in later in scripture. I also noticed some of the Levitical laws that were already a law back with Judah and the issue with his sons and his daughter-in-law Tamar. If you are paying close attention, you can get a glimpse of Jesus in the Old Testament Scriptures. What a joy to open my Bible every morning and read something new and even read something I knew but seeing it in a different light. If you haven't read the bible through, I highly recommend reading it through with the Bible Recap.

If that seems too much for you right now, the MABS (Monday Afternoon Bible Study) group, meets at 3 on Mondays. We are starting a study on 1<sup>st</sup> John. For the next 2 Mondays for an hour, we are going to use 3 different Bible translations and read 1<sup>st</sup> John 3 times and pause between each reading to meditate on the scripture. Come join us. If you are one who cannot make that time, I do not mind starting a Tuesday evening session. Pray about it and let me know.


