

The Thrift Store will be closing out their winter-wear inventory and will be looking for gently used children's clothes for spring & summer.






Please take a look at the following items regarding our ongoing construction project, our plan to have it dedicated and ready to use prior to VBS, and the opening of our Preschool in August!
