



John 19.34: "Instead, one of the soldiers pierced his side with a spear, and at once blood and water came out."

I have a good friend who is a medical doctor and he used to teach in the Medical School at University of Charleston. I asked him to do some research to explain to me how this passage above is possible. He spoke about things that are horrific and traumatic that would have to occur for a person's heart to enlarge under severe conditions. He talked about the angle of the spear, so as to avoid the rib cage. He talked about why water would come out – and how that water was based on trauma caused to the

individual. And in that moment, I had an epiphany. The horrors of Jesus' death are for my redemption. The trauma that Jesus endured, is for my reconciliation. The empire piercing his side, pierces Jesus' heart, and therefore he is exposed to the world.

God is vulnerable. God suffers. God dies.

This time of year, we want so much to go to the resurrection. Maybe this year wallow in Jesus' death. Be reminded that the blood and water flowed from his heart because of trauma, horrors, and spears. Be reminded that you can't have Easter without Good Friday – and if you try to – you don't really understand Easter. We have opportunities during the next few days to look closely at Jesus' death – and to the void that we find in an empty tomb. I would encourage you to wallow in Jesus' death. So that in his death you might find hope.
