Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And do not lead us into temptation but deliver us from evil. [For Thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory forever. Amen] Mathew 6:9-13 NASB

Jesus taught His disciples how to pray, and if we would follow suit we could pray as well. But I hear some say that they are not good at praying, or I just do not feel comfortable praying. Some even say they do not know how to pray. We are to follow along with scripture Jesus teaches us. We have a book of Psalms in the Bible that is loaded with prayers. And the prayer on Mathew that Jesus taught us.

Dietrich Bonhoeffer in his book "Psalms, the prayer book of the Bible", he mentions that *prayer does not mean simply to pour out one's heart. It means rather to find the way to God and to speak with Him, whether the heart is full or empty. No one can do that on one's own. For that, one needs Jesus Christ.*

So, we must learn to pray. Children learn to speak because their parents speak to them. The child learns the speech of his or her parents. So, we learn to speak to God because God has spoken to us and speaks to us. By means of the speech of the Father in heaven, His children learn to speak with Him. Repeating God's own words after Him, we begin to pray to Him. We ought to speak to God and He wants to hear us, not in the false and confused speech of our heart, but in the clear and pure speech which God has spoken to us in Jesus Christ.

God's speech in Jesus Christ meets us in the Holy Scriptures. If we wish to pray with confidence and gladness, then the words of Holy Scripture will have to be the solid basis of our prayer. For here we know that Jesus Christ, the Word of God, teaches us to pray. The words which come from God become, then, the steps on which we find our way to God.




