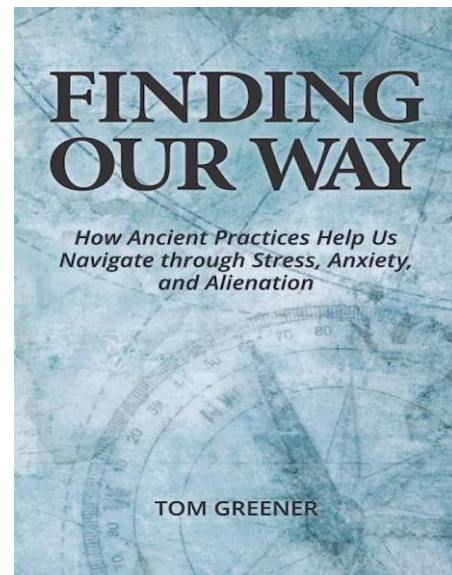




I Corinthians 3.11: For no one can lay any foundation other than the one that has been laid; that foundation is Jesus Christ.

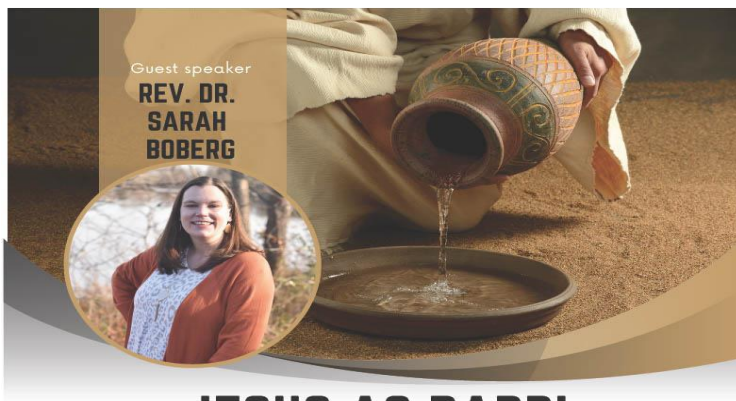
