

Camino de Santiago Pilgrimage

Pastor Chryst and his wife, DeAnne, left on Tuesday of this week to experience a pilgrimage. This is a trip they have been planning for years. What's a pilgrimage? A pilgrimage is a journey, often into an unknown or foreign place, where a person goes in search of new or expanded meaning about themselves, others, nature, and a higher good through the experience. It can lead to a personal transformation, after which the pilgrim returns to their daily life. As you may know, before coming to Surf City, Pastor Chryst worked for 9 years successfully starting a Methodist Church in downtown Wilmington which largely served the homeless community there. The work was very tough, with long hours and countless hurdles and he established a congregation of followers in the heart of the city, where they need to Jesus. His transfer to Faith Harbor was an important transition for him and for us here at Faith Harbor. He had planned this 5-week pilgrimage during the transition, but we really needed him at Faith Harbor, so they agreed to wait until this time. They will be going to Spain to walk an ancient pilgrimage called the Camino de Santiago (translated, it is "The Way of St. James" and you can read more on-line, just "Google" it). This is a 500 mile walk that countless Christian pilgrims have been traveling for close to 1500 years! DeAnne will return the second week of October and Philip will be returning on October 26th.

The symbol of this pilgrimage is a scallop shell, so we will use that image in our various communications and Sunday bulletins so we can all be in prayer for them as they make this incredible journey.

We will be welcoming different preachers on Sundays for the next several weeks. For example, next week we will welcome Rev. Bruce Stanley, who is the CEO of the Methodist Home for Children.
