

Ephesians 4.11-13: "The gifts he gave were that some would be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, until all of us come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to maturity, to the measure of the full stature of Christ."

We are going to take some time to help equip the saints for the work of the ministry over the next several months. We are going to spend some time reading together as a congregation a seminal work by a missionary named Lesslie Newbigin. Lesslie Newbigin was a Church of Scotland missionary to India and served in India from 1936-1974. While serving as a missionary he helped form a cooperative denomination called Church of South India, where he became

a Bishop. In order for the schools that were under his care to learn more about the basic tenants of the Christian faith, he decided to write a small book to help the teachers at these schools. This book is called *Sin & Salvation*.

The book is intriguing when it comes to equipping the saints because of how it starts out in his prelude. Newbigin states: he decided to treat the church before faith because "it is the order which the non-Christian has to follow when he comes to Christ. What he sees is a visible congregation in his village. It is that congregation which holds out to him the offer of salvation." This notion of starting with the church, in a theological primer such as his book *Sin & Salvation*, allows us the opportunity to look at the church from a position of entry point to faith.

We are going to meet right at 10.45am for 45 minutes to discuss this book as a congregation. The dates are as follows: (April 21, 28; May 5, 12; June 2, 9, 16, 23, 30). There will be childcare provided. We will be taking a chapter a week (including the prelude the first week). This is bound to be a time for us to be equipped for the work of the ministry that each one of us is called to be about. 
