



Ephesians 4:12 "to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up."

I was honored when Pastor Philip asked me to write a piece for the Messenger about Stacie Holmes and what God is doing in her life. I've known Stacie for several years, but the more I've gotten to know her the more I've realized what an amazing gift she is to our church and community. Stacie and her husband Greg along with their two daughters, Grace and Carly, have been coming to Faith Harbor since 2017. Whenever you talk with Stacie you know she is filled with the Grace of God. She is devoted to helping others and through that she started the Women's Study Group that meets every

Wednesday at Faith Harbor, where women of faith can share their stories, collectively pray for those in need, and discuss how Christ through scripture teaches us how to live. I was also privileged to spend time with her in Discipleship class where I saw how God was working through her.

In 2015, Stacie was going through a lot of changes, leaving what was familiar in her life, and she was questioning what her path was going to be. On a CBS retreat she was struggling and praying on what her purpose was and asking God for guidance. While she was there, God answered her by directing her to Ephesians 4:12. His words continued over that week referring her to that specific scripture. She reflected on it deeply knowing this was God's word, giving her a sign to follow, but she was still unsure what exactly she was to do. Then in February of 2016, she and Greg formed Operation Military Kids Club, an organization to help school children of military families connect with others and become part of a community. They held the first session in their home. By that summer, Greg was deployed, and Stacie knew that she and her daughters would need a community. She put her efforts into OMKC, rounding up volunteers and meeting with school liaison officers. They started meeting once a month at North Topsail and soon had sixty kids in the program. In 2017, Stacie became President of the organization and by the third year they were meeting at North Topsail, South Topsail, Topsail Elementary and Middle School and eventually Surf City. She was instrumental in getting a partnership agreement between the Superintendent of Schools and the liaison officers from Camp LeJeune in coordinating the purchasing of supplies needed. They now also meet at Topsail High School and have grown from 60 kids to over 350.

This Sunday, Stacie will be awarded the Harry Denman Evangelism Award by the Annual Council for her consistent and humble acts of service. Only one layperson a year receives the award. We are blessed to have her as part of our congregation and know that God's light will continue to shine through her. ~Kathy Winfield

June 13th: Roger Morton "Reading the Gospels, through the eyes of Jesus"


June 20th: Greg Holmes "The 3 C's of Finance"
