This last Wednesday we gathered together for a time of contemplation and sacrament. We have been practicing this order for almost two years. We gather at 9.30am on Wednesday mornings quietly and expectantly. We always read scripture passages based on the readings you can find in the bulletin.

Yesterday was a passage from I Corinthians 7.31: "For the present form of this world is passing away."

These are the words that stuck out to me yesterday – for they are words that remind us that our trust is found in the God who makes all things new. They are words that remind us that we are pilgrims on this journey – sharing of what we have with those around us – and recipients of the same generosity from those same fellow travelers. I have this image in my mind, that when we journey, what is behind us passes away, vanishes, and no longer exists. Beside us our our sisters, brothers, strangers, and Jesus, who is yoked with us. But what lies before us is the hope of glory – that we currently see through a glass dimly.

My sisters & brothers – let us journey with one another – sharing of what we have. Let us carry one another – and sometimes be carried by one another. Let us trust the Lord – the one who makes all things new.


