



Ephesians 4.11-13: "The gifts he gave were that some would be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, until all of us come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to maturity, to the measure of the full stature of Christ."

I love the eclectic nature of the body of Christ. How we are all different, and those differences are something that is God-given and God-inspired. We can observe the eclectic nature of God in creation – from Sea Horses to Elephants – from volcanoes to desserts – from Pleiades to Orion.

In this passage from Ephesians chapter four we learn about God's eclectic nature of calling people with particular gifts to do particular things. And all of these gifts that God gave were for equipping, building up, unity, knowledge, and maturity. This was so the people of God would grow into "the measure of the full stature of Christ."

As we come to the conclusion of our study of the book of Ephesians, we are going to celebrate the eclectic nature of the body of Christ and invite everyone to respond. And that response is through creating. This Sunday, March 2nd at 8am & 9.30am we will be having an Art Sunday. We are inviting everyone to create something to share this Sunday. That creation might be a drawing, sculpture, pottery, wooden carving, painting, song, poem, dance, etc. Plan to bring your creation this Sunday and display it on one of the tables near the altar. All are invited to participate in this response to God's word found in the book of Ephesians.
