

Luke 23.34: "Then Jesus said, 'Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing.'"

We are beginning a series of looking at the last words of Jesus. This is based on a book written by Stanley Hauerwas called *Cross-Shattered Christ*. During the Lenten season we will be attending closely to Jesus' crucifixion. Hauerwas writes about this on p21 when he says: "I hope those reading this book will discover, as I was forced to discover, how extraordinary it is that our lives have been redeemed, literally made possible, by the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ."

I would encourage you to plumb the depths of the crucifixion this Lenten season. Let us not be in a hurry to get to Easter Sunday – instead let us fully embrace Jesus's death – the second person of the Trinity's death – the Son of God's death. As we navigate the complexities of this death, let us stand at the foot of the cross together. Let us stand there in awe and wonder at the extraordinary nature of this event – and be reminded that God suffered, God was crucified, God died.


