

College Bowl Food Raiser

Week 1 was rather lackluster with only 97 total items counted. Ohio State was leading with 43 items followed by NC State with 38 items with Clemson and UNC trailing badly. Only four out of the 13 schools participating had donations. However, Week 2 was a complete turnaround. All schools showed signs of life with a record breaking 623 items donated. Due to the massive amount of goods collected in week 2 a decision was made to take it directly to Share the Table instead of waiting until the end of the month. The total weight of the delivery was 746 pounds. The combined total for week 1 and week 2 is 720 units. With only two more weeks to go, now is not the time to let up.

The generosity that has been shown by the congregation is overwhelming, and I thank everyone from the bottom of my heart. UNC (boo) leads the field with 201 items followed by Ohio State and Roanoke College respectively, see the attached chart.

I would like to thank all the men who helped count, box, and deliver the goods to Share the Table.
