



John 13.31-35: "When he had gone out, Jesus said, 'Now the Son of Man has been glorified, and God has been glorified in him. If God has been glorified in him, God will also glorify him in himself and will glorify him at once. Little children, I am with you only a little longer. You will look for me; and as I said to the Jews so now I say to you, "Where I am going, you cannot come." I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

On that last night of Jesus' life, he washes his disciples feet and has a last supper with them. He then gives them some last instructions that you see above. His instructions involve that they cannot come with him. But he tells them that they should love one another, just like he has loved them. And this isn't just an idea he has — it is a new commandment. He says that by doing this — by loving each other — people outside of their circle of twelve will know that they are Jesus' disciples. This love shared is an indication of discipleship. In some sense it is the test the world has for us — that we love one another.

We are going to share that love of Jesus and one another by partnering with another church for Maundy Thursday (Thursday, April 17th at 7pm) and Good Friday – Stations of the Cross (Friday, April 18th at 7pm).

Maundy Thursday – Thursday, April 17th at 7pm We will be welcoming Manhollow Missionary Baptist Church to Faith Harbor United Methodist Church (14201 US Hwy 50, Surf City) for a joint worship service. Rev. Dante Murphy will be preaching, and Manhollow Musicians will be sharing in song. Faith Harbor Choir will also be doing a special Maundy Thursday selection. All are invited.

Good Friday – Stations of the Cross – Friday, April 18th at 7pm We are invited to Manhollow Missionary Baptist Church (55 Manhollow Church Road, Hampstead) for a joint Stations of the Cross service that will begin in the sanctuary and proceed out to the church's lawn. Pastors and musicians from both churches will be sharing in scripture readings and songs. All are invited.

College Bowl Food Raiser

- Week 1 was rather lackluster, with only 97 total items counted. Ohio State was leading with 43 items followed by NC State with 38 items with Clemson and UNC trailing badly. Only four out of the 13 schools participating had donations.
- Week 2 was a complete turnaround. All schools showed signs of life with a record-breaking 623 items donated. Due to the massive amount of goods collected in Week 2 a decision was made to take the items directly to Share the Table instead of waiting until the end of the month. The total weight of the delivery was 746 pounds.
- Week 3 the race is on! UNC continues leading with 213 items, followed closely by Roanoke with 207 items, leaving Ohio State in third place with 181 items.
- The combined total for Week 1, Week 2, and Week 3 is 1,165 units, which broke last year's total. With only one more week to go, now is not the time to let up.
- Week 4 was another barn burner with 527 total items donated and breaking last year's total by almost 600 items. The winner will be announced at the 9:30 service on Sunday, you don't want to miss it!
