



Hebrews 12.3: "Consider Jesus who endured such hostility against himself from sinners, so that you may not grow weary or lose heart."

This time of year, we are invited to consider Jesus' last week – leading up to his death. We pause this time of year and contemplate this holy week. We do it personally – in our prayers, scripture reading, and meditation. We also do it communally – as we

gather for worship and consider corporately Jesus' life, death, and resurrection. The author of Hebrews adjures us to consider this rage, mob violence, hostility, and murder.

We do this at Faith Harbor in very intentional and creative ways – and they are ways that invite the entire community to participate. We invite our community to celebrate the parade of palms & hosannas – with a time of celebration of an Easter Egg Hunt. This is always a great time – but there is an air of dread that is implicit in this celebration – because we personally & corporately know this leads to Golgotha.

We invite our community to consider the week leading up to Jesus' death by inviting the community to a foot washing, a healing service, a Seder meal, Maundy Thursday, and Stations of the Cross – where we gaze upon the cross where Jesus died. We also invite folks from 9am-5pm on Good Friday to come personally and consider the art in the sanctuary, that is a self-guided reflection on that dreadful Friday scene.

This solemn and dreadful week is an experiential opportunity to live into what the writer of Hebrews is urging us to consider. It is a communal opportunity to live out this calling. I would urge you to follow Jesus all the way to the place of death in a borrowed tomb. This experience includes highs and lows. Job Type: Part-time

**Job Summary:** The Church Audio-Visual Technician will be responsible for creating and executing visual presentations for Sunday services, operating sound equipment during worship services, managing video capture and streaming services, and overseeing a team of AV volunteers. This role is instrumental in ensuring that our congregation receives a seamless and spiritually uplifting experience during worship services.

### Job Responsibilities:

#### 1. Visual Presentations:

- Create and design visual presentations, including slideshows, videos, lyrics and graphics, to enhance the worship experience.
- Collaborate with the worship team and pastors as needed to integrate visuals that complement the message and theme of each service.

### 2. Sound Equipment Operation:

- Set up, operate, and maintain audio equipment, including microphones, mixers, and speakers, to ensure high-quality sound during Sunday services and other events.
- Perform sound checks and adjustments to ensure clear and balanced audio.

## 3. Video Capture and Streaming:

- Operate AV recording and streaming equipment to broadcast services to remote audiences.
- Monitor and troubleshoot any technical issues during live streaming, ensuring a smooth and uninterrupted online experience.

- Recruit, train, and schedule a team of AV volunteers to assist with various audio-visual tasks.

## FROM THE FINANCE TEAM: By the Numbers - A Financial Update

During the 2024 budget year, Church finances underwent two major changes. The first was the restructuring of the Chart of Accounts and the second was the conversion to a new accounting firm and the account review and cleanup afterwards. Both events are having an impact on the ability to effectively close out the 2024 financial year. However, the work continues, and I hope for a successful completion. It is important to note that the Finance Committee at that time did a masterful job in keeping everything under control. Even though there were questions raised during the year concerning the finances an internal audit revealed that there were transactions that were mistakenly applied to the wrong account but were later identified and corrected. In addition, all of the transactions were legitimate and in keeping with Church policy. In the end all funds were accounted for and not one penny was lost.

The good news is that we have learned from our mistakes and have taken action to prevent any further misinterpretations of our financial policies and procedures. There were a number of short-term policies put into place at that time which addressed several issues and strengthened our internal controls while a review and a complete rewrite of the current policy and procedures manual was underway.

I am happy to announce that the new and more comprehensive version of the financial policy and procedures manual will be announced in the coming weeks. Remember you heard it here first! Stay tuned for further updates as we begin to explore our current year's finances.


