


God sends Us!



Acts 13.1-3: "Now in the church at Antioch there were prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon who was called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen a member of the court of Herod the ruler, and Saul. While they were worshipping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, 'Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them.' Then after fasting and praying they laid their hands on them and sent them off."

I love this language "set apart". This language is used by the Holy Spirit for instruction to the church about a particular group of people – Barnabas & Saul. And this group was set apart "for the work to which I have called them." These two men have a particular work which requires them to be set apart for them to live into the calling. And the church is the vehicle that sets them apart.

Barnabas & Saul had spent a year in Antioch teaching many people in the church (Acts 11.26). This teaching enabled and empowered the church to be very creative and imaginative. They created the name Christian (Acts 11.26), and they had a missional imagination to the prophetic prediction of famine (Acts 11.29). All of this set up the church in Antioch to be a sending church, much like the church in Jerusalem that sent Barnabas to Antioch (Acts 11.22).

It is amazing to read about the missional imagination that engaged the Christian community – and called the community to practice what they had seen and heard about Jesus. This calling turned into missionaries like Barnabas and Saul being sent all over the Mediterranean to share the Good News found in Jesus Christ.

In so many ways I see Faith Harbor as a sending church. We send missionaries to Panama, Western North Carolina – we send people to become pastors in West Virginia and now Sneads Ferry. This Sunday we are getting a chance to send off our own Stacie Holmes to be the pastor of The Edge United Methodist Church in Sneads Ferry. The Holy Spirit is calling Stacie to be set apart for the work that she is called to – and we get the humble responsibility to send.

I would encourage you all to be in prayer for Stacie Holmes as she is being called to listen to what the Holy Spirit is instructing her and to have the courage to do what the Holy Spirit is calling her to.

About the Workshop:

Since 1996, when the General Conference of The United Methodist Church adopted a resolution aimed at eliminating potential for abuse in the church, abuse prevention has been an important part of church policymaking and implementation. United Methodists are called to justice and advocacy for those whose voices are often overlooked or not heard, including children, youth, and vulnerable adults. Churches are responsible for ensuring a safe environment for all persons. The risk of harm to children, youth, and vulnerable

adults can be reduced through the implementation of abuse prevention policies. A primary focus for the NCC Safer Sanctuaries Team is to provide resources that will help churches as they develop policies, train staff and volunteers, and implement those policies. Individual church policies should be written with consideration of the church's specific context, so there is not a one-size-fits-all policy.

Recommendations for abuse prevention policy content is offered by the NCC Safer Sanctuaries Team and may be found on the <u>webpage</u>. This workshop is for church leaders who will train others in abuse prevention. Attendees are encouraged to bring a copy of their church abuse prevention policy.

Safer Sanctuaries: Training Leaders in Abuse Prevention is led by Rev. Charlotte Brendel, current chair of the NCC Safer Sanctuaries Team.
