****A note from the Thrift Store...***

As Christians, it is our mission to spread kindness and help the less fortunate. That is what the Thrift Store family is all about. We are providing our report for the past 14 years to let our congregation know where our profits have been distributed. It is just not one cause, but several. We realize that there are several great organizations in our community that ask for donations. But we are asking, as we have since the Thrift Store's inception, September 2010, to think of us as you clean out your household items and furniture.

Our rent has increased \$600 a month, which equates to an annual increase of \$7,200. That is \$7,200 less that we will be able to distribute in 2025 to those in need.

We are also in desperate need of volunteers to serve as salesclerks. A shift is only three hours (10-1 or 1-4) Tuesday through Friday during the summer. You can volunteer for one day or multiple days each month.

As you may ponder how to make a difference, any consideration of your time or donations would be appreciated. As a closing note, Faith Harbor Thrift Store has distributed \$227,658 since 2010 – not only helping the needy (\$125,078) but also helping our FHUMC Church:

Bldg. 1&2- (\$16,180)

Apportionments- (\$34,400)

BTV- (\$40,000)

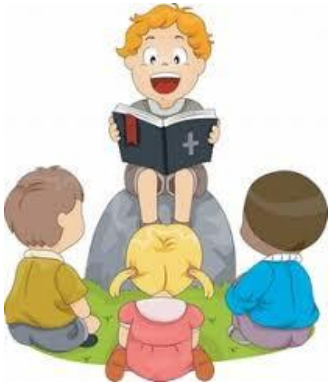
Our Children's Ministry
