





Acts 2.44-47: "All who believed were together and had all things in common; they would sell their possessions and goods and distribute the proceeds to all, as any had need. Day by day, as they spent much time together in the temple, they broke bread at home and ate their food with glad and generous hearts, praising God and having the goodwill of all the people. And day by day the Lord added to their number those who were being saved."

For the last several Sundays we have been reading *The Five Means of Grace* by Elaine Heath. We have been looking at Prayer, Searching the Scriptures, the Lord's Supper and Fasting. This Sunday, we will be looking at Holy Conferencing. Please plan on meeting in the Sanctuary at 10.45, as we complete our discussion. This study is allowing us, as a community of faith, to understand the methodical nature of participating in God's grace. The rhythms, habits, and repetition of these practices invites us to grow more in our love of God, love of each other, and love of ourselves. We need each other in order to grow in holiness and in our commitment to God. The faith that we have is a personal faith, but it can never be a private faith. It is a faith that is practiced with the community of faith, just like we read in Acts 2.44-47. In this passage we read about sharing, spending time together daily, eating in each other's homes, and having the goodwill of all the people. This is a community of faith that is centered on the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
