



Psalm 14.1: "Fools say in their hearts, "There is no God."

This passage is such an intriguing way to look at atheism. It isn't really atheism in the sense of a logical decision, instead an atheism that is snarky and divisive – while at the same time foolish.

As I have been praying this passage all week, I have been thinking about ways that I act foolish, as if there is no God. The foolish way of going about life thinking that I am the one who is in charge and is powerful – the ways in which I

forget to pray and to seek wise council – the ways I neglect to stand in awe and wonder of the greatness of God's splendor – and even the ways I forget that the people around me are there for my benefit because God has knit our hearts together. The psalmist calls this foolish.

Notice, the foolishness is not found in the logical decision of atheism, instead it is in the heart of foolish people that operate as if there is no God. For one can profess one thing – yet live another way.

My sisters and brothers, may we live our lives dependent on the great God almighty, the God is and is and is to come. The great God that we see manifested in the person and work of Jesus Christ. In this dependence, may we not rely on our own strength, but instead on the strength of the one who made us in his image and after his likeness. May our hearts proclaim dependence on our loving heavenly Father.

FROM THE FINANCE TEAM: By the Numbers - A summary of weekly revenues

Fun Facts: While doing research in preparation for the 2026 budget, I came across some interesting numbers when comparing our past giving to the current year. In 2024 our overall YTD giving (as of 9/10/2024) was \$361,189.76 and out of that total, 81.6% was for Tithes & Offerings totaling \$294,727.52. Comparing that to the 2025 YTD overall giving we have \$451,889.72 of which 60% went to Tithes & Offerings totaling \$270,705.41. Even though our overall giving increased in 2025, our Tithes & Offerings decreased by 20% over the same period last year. We are a very generous congregation, which I am proud to be a member, but we also need to be diligent with our tithing. In order to meet our expenses by the end of the year we will need to increase our tithing percentage over the next few months. I bring this to your attention because this will have a direct impact on the 2026 budget.
