



Ezekiel 1.15-20: “As I looked at the living creatures, I saw a wheel on the earth beside the living creatures, one for each of the four of them. As for the appearance of the wheels and their construction: their appearance was like the gleaming of beryl; and the four had the same form, their construction being something like a wheel within a wheel. When they moved, they moved in any of the four directions without veering as they moved. Their rims were tall and awesome, for the rims of all four were full of eyes all round. When the living creatures moved, the wheels moved beside them; and when the living creatures rose from the earth, the wheels rose. Wherever the spirit would go, they went, and the wheels rose along with them; for the spirit of the living creatures was in the wheels.”

The prophet Ezekiel sees the wheel within the wheel while he is with the exiles by the river Chebar. The rims, of the wheels, are full of eyes. And these wheels go wherever the spirit goes. This is a revelation from the Lord for the prophet Ezekiel. Minnie Evans (1892-1987) had revelations from the Lord as well. Minnie Evans was a gifted artist from Wilmington that had great influence on the Harlem Renaissance. Her work can be seen in places all over Wilmington, while at the same time in places like the Museum of Modern Art in New York.

This Sunday, Chris Peeler (you can see Chris in the picture with Peg Strohecker – Children's Minister) is going to share about some of Minnie Evans experiences with our children in Jr. bAsIC. This will be based on the book *Painting Dreams: Minnie Evans, Visionary Artist*, by Mary E. Lyons. Chris will then lead the children in an artistic exercise using Minnie Evans's artwork as an example.
